TOPIC

“Inadequacy of the Arbitration Act of Tanzania in resolving commercial disputes; a need to repeal

The objective of the competition is to digest and review the *Arbitration Act Cap 15 R. E. 2002* of Tanzania with the intention to confirm the dire need for its amendment.

COMPETITION RULES

1. The paper must not exceed 1500 words, including preliminary pages excluding bibliography/annexes.
2. The paper must be type written, 1.5 line spacing, and Times New Roman 12 point font.
3. The papers must be sent by e-mail, preferably as Word documents or in PDF format.
4. The TI Arb Judging Committee will be established and shall consist of 5 members they will judge the paper based on legal argumentation, research, style, logic, originality and overall quality of the content.
5. The Judging Committee will communicate its decision within 60 days or any period as may be determined by the TI Arb. The decision of the Judging Committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The decision will be published on the TI Arb’s website. Winners will be contacted at the e-mail address used to submit their Papers.
6. The TI Arb Judging Committee has the right to publish a selection of the papers submitted, including but not limited to the winning paper (either the full text or extracts thereof) after the Competition has ended; this includes but is not limited to the publication in the conference documentation and/or on the TI Arb’s website and/or in the TI Arb’s Newsletter and/or other TI Arb’s publications.
7. The prize for the winning paper is as follows:
 - a) The winner will have the opportunity to be allocated a mentor / an opportunity to observe an arbitration administered by the Institute;
 - b) A one (1) year free membership subscription (for an existing member);
 - c) Free delegate pass to the 4th TI Arb Annual Arbitration Conference 2020.
8. The TI Arb’s Judging Committee and the organizers of the competition are not responsible for the loss, damage or non-arrival of any paper, nor for any costs or expenses incurred in the preparation or the submission of any paper.
