Eligibility Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nationality: Open to foreign nationals with relevant experience in Alternative Dispute Resolution and in particular arbitration. • Age: Applicants must be at least 34-75 years old. • Professional Experience: a minimum of 10 years post-qualified experience in the field of arbitration, mediation or adjudication (ADR). In their applications, the applicants must demonstrate their ongoing experience in arbitration/mediation or adjudication whether in their capacity as arbitrator/mediator or adjudicator and/or counsel. Other relevant experience such as those acquired as tribunal secretary, expert witnesses and other professional undertakings in arbitration practice, mediation or adjudication as may be considered by the Council, on a case-by-case basis. • Practical Experience: For Arbitrator/Adjudicator empanelment, the Applicant must demonstrate through submission of redacted copies evidence of having issued at least five decisions, substantive orders or awards in international cases. • Membership: Applicants must hold Fellowship or similar accreditations from professional membership organisations in arbitration such as the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators or other organisations akin to such.
Registration with Relevant Authorities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foreign applicants must comply with all Tanzania Regulatory Authorities, including obtaining the necessary work permits to operate as a neutral in the country, be accredited through the Ministry of Constitution and Legal affairs.
Application Documentation	<p>Applicants must submit the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cover Letter: A formal letter expressing interest for empanelment on the TIArb International list of arbitrator, mediators or adjudicator. • Curriculum Vitae (CV): A detailed CV highlighting qualifications, experience, and notable achievements in dispute resolution. A brief portfolio summarizing cases handled, including types of disputes, industries involved, and roles played. • Qualifications: Copies of academic and professional certificates. Proof of certification as a qualified and accredited arbitrator, mediator, or adjudicator from a recognized body.
